

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE COMPLETED EMT ARTICULATED COURSES AT THE ROP/HIGH SCHOOL**

Students who have a signed completion of articulated course form from their ROP/ High School teacher may be able to obtain college credit from Santa Ana College. This is accomplished by enrolling in the college within two years of completing the course and following the procedures below.

1. Bring your High School/ROP Completion of Articulation Course form if you **received a “B” or higher in the course(s)** signed by your ROP/High School instructor to the following office:

2. Parking: visitor parking (lot 3) is available in front of the Administration/Admissions “S” building for 30 minutes. (The Administration/Admissions building faces 17<sup>th</sup> street and there are two flagpoles in front of it).
3. **Provide your high school transcripts (can be unofficial), the signed *Completion of Articulated Course* form, a copy of your National Registry EMT license, and a copy of your current American Heart Association BLS CPR card to the Career Education Office (R-107) and explain that you would like to obtain college credit.**
4. In order to receive credit, you must be registered in at least one class at SAC or SCC for the current semester.
5. Once you complete the process, “Credit by Exam” units will be added to your college transcript in about 3 weeks. No letter grade is given.

Note: California State University and University of California (and other transfer institutions) may or may not accept credit for high school articulated CTE courses.
